- Q2. We always walk to school but come home by bus.
- Q3. You play football better than me but I play the guitar better than you.
- Q4. I wear the same shoes every day.
- **Q5.** John and Claire **live** with their parents in another town.
- Q6. Okay. Non-continuous verb, 'seem'.
- Q7. Not okay. The verb 'to smell' is not used in this way. We would say 'The food smells bad.
- Q8. Not okay. It should be 'After he goes home', as it is a future time clause.
- Q9. Okay. It's a timetabled future event.
- Q10. Okay. This is a habit.
