 - **Q9.** If Andy wore floral ties, everybody would love him even more.
 - **Q10.** Alex would be able to participate if the questions weren't so hard.

- A3. If Sally had seen the swan, she would have swooned.
- A4. If they had cooked, it would have been a disaster.
- A5. She would have been happy if Peter had come.
- A6. If I hadn't understood, I would have said so.
- A7. I would have hated him if he had done that!
- A8. Julie would have paid if she had had the money to.
- A9. If Andy had worn floral ties, everybody would have loved him even more.
- A10. Alex would have been able to participate if the questions hadn't been so hard.
